meaning of safe which means -S for Self protection


A for Awareness F for Familiarity E for Exchange

The aim of this programme was to create awareness among the girls. The programme also focussed on " on guard" "off guard" safety.


"On guard situation" means within the home and "off guard situation" means outside the home. Basically it means how to protect girls in public places as well as in homes and at relatives' places.


